CLARIFICATIONS

Thank you for your interest and enthusiasm for the Nuremberg Moot Court 2020.

Preliminarily, it is important to note that a moot court scenario is, by definition, necessarily vague in order to provide enough room for debate and the development of arguments for both the Prosecution and the Defense.

Kindly note that we have considered all the requests for clarifications carefully. Questions raised but not addressed below were considered as already answered by the case or considered irrelevant for the preparation of the Pre-Trial Chamber hearing.

Case:

Clarification 1: *Para. 13:* For the thousands of Islanders who arrived in Cintria after March 2018, their asylum claims started to be automatically rejected without due process after Calanta came to power.

Clarification 2: *Para. 17:* The murder of the 12 Islanders did not occur on Cintrian territory.

Clarification 3: *Paras 16-17, 22:* The 12 Islander killed and the two Islanders shot during their transport by Cintrian police are under investigation at the ICC. They are not part of the 30 Islanders who died en route to the Republic of Verden.

Clarification 4: *Para. 27 (b):* The agenda for the PTC's hearing includes whether the case against Ms. Fiona Calanta concerning crimes against humanity of murder is admissible pursuant to article **17(1)(a)** and (d) of the Statute. The case has been amended accordingly.
