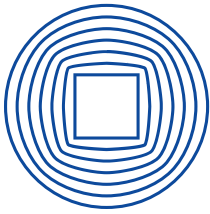

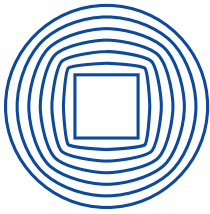

Author, *Title* (edition, year), p./para.

William Schabas, *Genocide in International Criminal Law: the Crime of Crimes* (2nd ed., 2009), p. 39.

Knut Dörmann, "Art. 8 para. 2 (b)(i)" in Triffterer (ed.), *Commentary on the Rome Statute of the International Criminal Court – Observers' Notes, Article by Article* (2nd ed., 2008), para. 31.

#### References:

The full details of a publication (as detailed above) should be given for the first reference only. For the other references, please use a short title:

First reference: Antonio Cassese, "Is the ICC still having Teething Problems?", *Journal of International Criminal Justice*, 4 (2006), p. 438 ("Antonio Cassese, 2006").

Following references: Antonio Cassese, 2006, p. 438.

For primary sources such as international treaties and international case law, any short title may be used so long as it avoids confusion with other sources.

Please avoid any confusion with other publications.

Do not cross-reference footnotes, such as see *supra* note 2, p. 203.
